#### **Payment**

Entry Fees can be paid for by mailing a check OR online using our new payment platform through PlayerFirst.

You will receive a confirmation e-mail from AES for the team(s) you registered. You will also receive an email from PlayerFirst, within an hour of your AES registration.

The confirmation from PlayerFirst will contain a link that will allow you to log-in and pay online.

**Note:** All checks should be made payable to 3STEP Sports, LLC. Please send one check per club, and include your official event entry form.

#### Complete payment is due no later than February 1, 2025.

**Note:** Payment does not guarantee acceptance. Teams are accepted based on order of payment received and room in the event. If the division is full by the payment deadline, the team(s) will be waitlisted until a space opens. If a space does not open, the waitlisted team(s) will be refunded.

## **Refund Policy**

- Teams that withdraw before 1/18/25 will receive a full refund.
- Teams that withdraw after 1/18/25 but before 2/8/25 will receive a 50% refund.
- Teams that withdraw after 2/8/25 are not eligible for a refund.

## **Online Team Check-in**

Online team check-in will open on Wednesday, 3/5/25 at 12:00 PM (ET) and will close on Friday, 3/7/25 at 8:00 PM (ET) through AES. Club Directors must verify the rosters by 8 PM on March 7<sup>th</sup> to confirm that their rosters are accurate, and the team is ready to compete.

## Player and Coach Credentials Pick-up

Tournament credentials are required for all athletes and coaches to enter the venues throughout the tournament. Coaches may pick up their credentials Saturday morning at their respective venue unless otherwise specified in email communications from 3Step.

Teams can pick up their credentials on <u>Saturday</u> before their matches start.

## Admissions & Ticketing

Tickets are ALL pre-sold through the Irish Rumble Ticket page. Tickets will be available for purchase closer to the event.

Everyone entering the event over the age of 10, including siblings of players, MUST have a ticket. Spectator wristbands must be worn on the wrist.

Refunds must be requested <u>within 30 days of purchase</u> via email to <u>tickets@topcourtevents.com</u>. Refund requests should include the name of the event, name of the purchaser, and which ticket(s) the request is for. Tickets that have been scanned are NOT eligible for a refund.

Tickets are not able to be refunded after the 30 days post purchase due to our ticketing software.

#### Venue Details

- Doors Open
  - Doors open at each venue one hour before the first matches are set to start.
- Lost & Found
  - If you believe you lost something during the event, please connect with the tournament desk or venue staff. Any lost items left at our events will be given to the venue.
- Athletic Trainers

 Trainers are available for preventative taping and injury response, evaluation, and treatment, as well as post-play treatment (ice/wrapping). Athletes should bring their own tape. Tape provided by the trainers is designated for injuries only.

#### Venue Specific Information

- Spooky Nook Sports
  - Parking:
    - Parking is \$10/day and \$20/weekend
      - Carpooling is encouraged due to limited parking.
      - All cars MUST enter the parking lot via 75 Champ Blvd.
      - Cars will not be able to access the general parking lot from the main entrance on Spooky Nook Rd.
  - Outside Food
    - No coolers or outside food are allowed into the facility.
    - A Smoothie Bar, Food Court, and full restaurant are available on-site.
  - Spectator Seating & Team Camping
    - Spectator seating is available, but personal chairs are allowed.
    - Team Camping is available on the second floor mezzanine.
- Lancaster Convention Center
  - Parking
    - Garage parking is available for a fee
    - Street parking is also available in the area (may have fees)
  - Outside Food
    - Limited food options are available inside the venue.
    - Outside food is allowed in the hotel lobby but is not allowed inside the playing area.
  - Spectator Seating and Team Camping
    - Spectator seating is available inside the playing venue.
    - Team Camping is allowed on the lowest level of the venue.
    - Team Camping is not allowed inside the playing area.
- York Expo Center
  - Parking
    - Parking is available at no cost
    - The easiest entrance is through Gate 4 off Market St.
  - Outside Food
    - No outside food or coolers are allowed. There are concessions available on site.
  - Spectator Seating and Team Camping

- Spectator seating is available inside the playing venue.
- There is no room for team camping. Please keep belongings tight to your group when your team is not playing.

## **Spectator Code of Conduct**

All Top Court Events and Northeast Power Series spectators must adhere to the following Spectator Code of Conduct:

- Spectators are an important part of the game and shall always conform to accepted standards of good sportsmanship and behavior.
- Be respectful of all athletes, coaches, officials, other spectators, and tournament staff.
- Taunting, foul and abusive language, and disrespectful signs and behavior have no place in youth sports and will not be tolerated. **This is a zero-tolerance policy.**
- Any physical or verbal altercations with athletes, coaches, officials, other spectators, or tournament staff will not be tolerated. Offending parties will immediately be escorted out of the venue and banned from returning to the premises for the remainder of the event.
- Be respectful of event staff, security, and rules of the event, along with the use of facilities and equipment provided, at all times.
- Spectators will observe the rules of the event venues concerning weapons, smoking, drugs, food/drink consumption, littering, and parking procedures.

#### **Tournament Format**

#### 4 Team Pools (2 Day Event):

The desired format for each division is four (4) team pools on Saturday followed by bracket play on Sunday. The results of pool play will determine where the teams will play on Sunday. In the desired format, 1st and 2nd place from pool play will go to Gold Bracket, 3rd place to Silver Bracket and 4th place to Bronze Bracket.

As mentioned, this is the desired format. However, this is subject to change and also is subject to the amount teams in the given division. Uneven numbers may require us to have the following:

- A pool of 3 that is playing automatic 3 Sets on Saturday.
- Two or three, three team pools, that will play normal best of 3 and then crossover between the pools to determine seeding for the bracket
- Bronze brackets that are actually 3 team pools for Sunday.
